Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects

BIG CAT OCTAGON PLATE



MATERIALS

Bl 656 Octagon Plate
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Small Brush
Fan Brush
Cheetah Pattern x2
NCR Paper or Tissue Paper
Straight Pin

COLORS

CMM 39 - Blue Green
CMM 19 - Banana Boat
CMM 73 - Safari
CMM 82 - Olive You
CMM 5 - Coral Reef
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 39 - Blue Green
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 44 - Battlefield

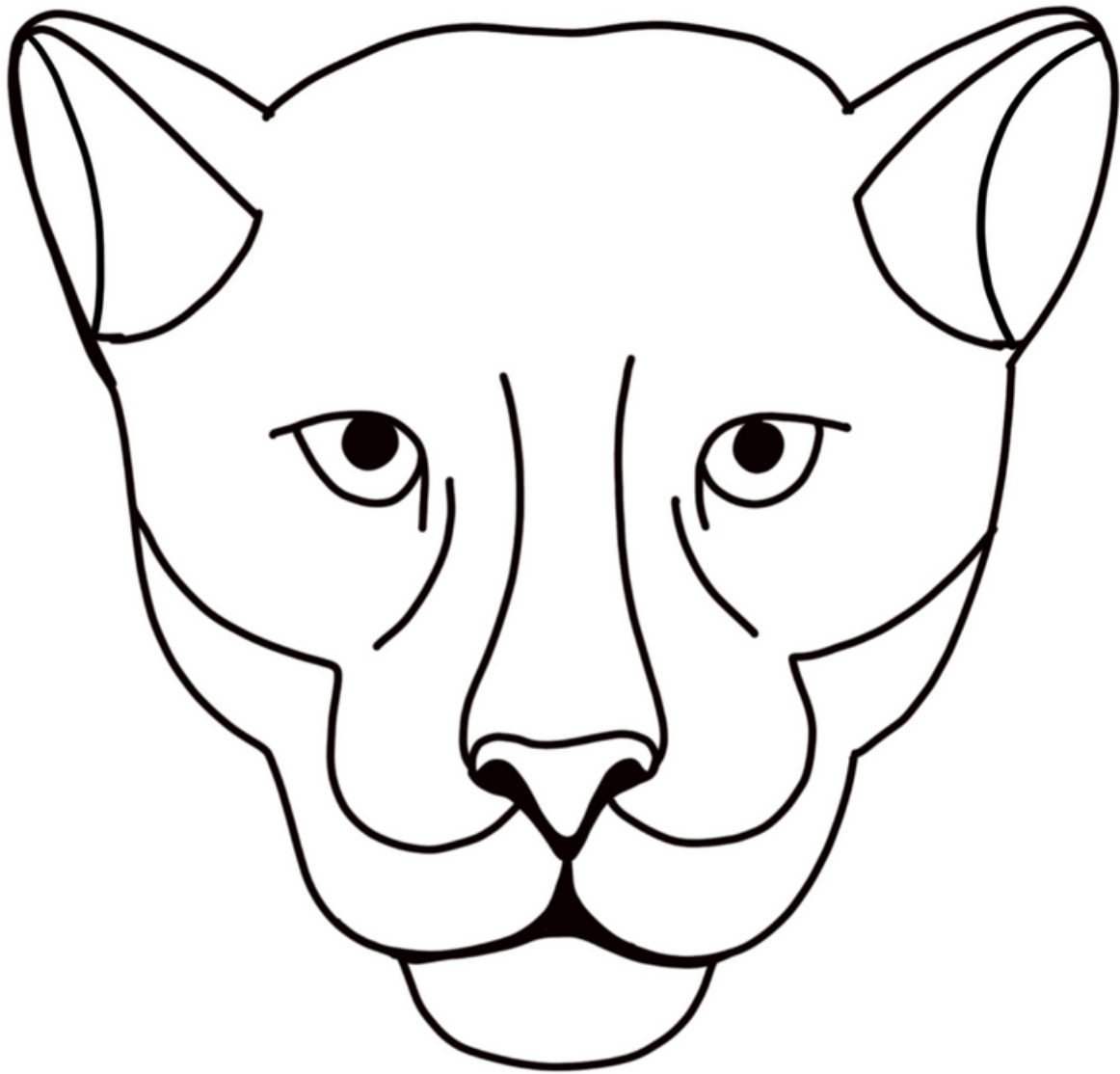
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use your fan brush to apply 2 coats of Snowflake to the inside part of the plate.
2. Cut out both of your cheetah patterns.
3. Dip one cheetah pattern in water and place it on the center of the plate and smooth out.
4. Use your fan brush to apply one more layer of Snowflake on top of the paper to insure that it is sealed down. Allow that to dry.
5. Once the white is dry, apply 3 coats of Coral Reef to the center part of the plate, going right on top of the paper. Allow that to dry.
6. Use your medium brush to apply 3 coats of Blue Green to the edge of the plate as well as the back.
7. When the back is dry, flip the plate over and use a straight pin to remove the paper pattern.
8. Now we are going to transfer on the details of the cheetah pattern using either NCR paper or the tissue paper transfer.
9. Using the photo of the finished sample as a reference, paint 3 coats of Banana Boat to the lighter golden sections of the face.
10. Then, paint 3 coats of Safari to the darker golden sections of the face.
11. Use your small brush to paint 3 coats of Battleship to inside the ear.
12. Now, use your detail brush to add 3 coats of Olive You to the eyes.
13. To paint the nose, use your detail brush to apply 3 coats of Coral Reef.
14. Finally add all the black outlines and spots using a 1 heavy coat of Licorice.

TIPS

- When applying the spots, just tap the brush on making imperfect spots.
- When you remove the paper pattern, don't pick at the edge with the pin. Instead, poke the paper about 1/4" from the edge and scoop upward to release it.
