

WATERCOLOR FLOWERS TINY FLOWERS PLANTER



MATERIALS

MB1557 Textured Planters Fan Brush Liner Brush Detail Brush Pencil or Water-Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie CMM 92 - Ghostly Grape CMM 47 - Deep Sea CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 29 - Grasshopper CMM 66 - Pink Berry

- 1. Water down the colors with 50% water to 50% paint.
- Use a detail brush to apply little flowers around each little knob on the side of the planter with 2 coats of paint.
- 3. Apply the center of the flower by painting the little knobs with 2 coats of paint.
- 4. Use a liner brush to apply some little leaves here and there among the flowers.
- 5. Paint the inside of the planter with 2 coats of the watered-down Pink Berry using a fan brush.
- 6. Use a small brush to apply 2 coats of watered-down Pink Berry to the rim of the planter.

TIPS

- By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
- If desired, use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch on the flowers.
- Allow the flowers and leaves to overlap slightly.
